RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Pensioners' Flats Loan 1959 of £19,000

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Henderson Borough Council held on the 15th day of February 1960:

Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Henderson Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £19,000 authorised to be raised by the Henderson Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing accommodation for aged persons, the said Henderson Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of forty-four hundredths of a penny (0.44d.) in the pound (£) on the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property in the Borough of Henderson; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 30 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

Pensioners' Flats Loan 1959, £4,500

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, the Mount Albert Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the One Tree Hill Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:
