ALL that area of land in the Canterbury Land District bounded by a line commencing at the easternmost corner of Lot 70, D.P. 1885, in Block IV, Elephant Hill Survey District, and proceeding south-westerly along the north-western side of the Deep Creek - Kurow Main Highway 120; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern side of that highway and Serpentine Valley Road to the angle on that roadside fronting part Lot 99, D.P. 1889; thence along a bearing of 56° 50' to the generally north-eastern boundary of Lot 70, D.P. 1855; thence south-easterly generally along the generally north-eastern boundaries of that lot to the point of commencement.
