*Tariff Notice—Application for Determination of the Minister of Customs*

NOTICE is hereby given that an application has been made for the classification, by determination of the Minister of Customs, of the under-mentioned goods under item 205 (16) (a) of the Customs Tariff of New Zealand:

- (1) Alkyd resins in solution or emulsion form including resins commercially designated as "Polyester resins".
- (2) Phenolic and or Phenol Formaldehyde resins in solution (either aqueous or solvent form).
- (3) Urea Formaldehyde and Melamine resins in solution (either aqueous or solvent form).
- (4) Maleic resins in solution.
- (5) Ester gum in solution.
- (6) Homopolymers and copolymers of Vinyl or Acrylic esters in emulsion form.

The application also requests that, in respect of the above-mentioned goods, the following rates of duty be imposed:

British preferential tariff	.....	25 per cent ad val.
General tariff	.....	25 per cent ad val.

The application will not be dealt with until 25 August 1960 and any person wishing to submit any objection thereto should do so in writing to the Comptroller of Customs, Private Bag, Wellington, on or before 25 August 1960.
