UNMANUFACTURED— Crepe rubber, even if masticated, being raw rubber not compounded or vulcanised Crepe rubber sheets, uncompounded, coloured or uncoloured, irrespective of the type of surface produced thereon Rubber sheet, smoked, being raw rubber passed through corrugated rollers which impart a ribbed pattern to both sides Latex, rubber, in ammonia Alloprene, butadeine, neoprene, and similar synthetic rubbers, in sheet or liquid form	307 307 307 307 307
