

## AUCKLAND METROPOLITAN DRAINAGE BOARD

## SPECIAL ORDER

Loan No. 28 1960, £1,000,000

THE Auckland Metropolitan Drainage Board, in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage Act 1944 and in pursuance of the authority conferred on it under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and their respective amendments, and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, doth hereby resolve by special resolution, intended to operate as a special order, to borrow the sum of £1,000,000 (one million pounds) for the purpose of meeting costs and expenses and carrying out works incidental to the first and second stage works of the Manukau Drainage Scheme.

The foregoing special order was made by way of a special resolution passed at a special meeting of the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage Board and held on the 6th day of July 1960. It was publicly notified in the *Auckland Star* and the *New Zealand Herald* on the 9th and 23rd days of July 1960. It was confirmed at a meeting of the Board, convened by resolution of the Board, on the 3rd day of August 1960.
