BOROUGH OF ASHBURTON

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1953

PURSUANT to the Town and Country Planning Regulations 1960, public notice is hereby given that the following variations to the district scheme, under the Town and Country Planning Act 1953, for the Borough of Ashburton was approved by the Council, by resolution passed at its meeting held on the 5th day of September 1960, after all objections, appeals, and arbitrations relating to the scheme had been disposed of and the scheme had been amended to give effect to all objections and appeals allowed and all variations of the scheme required by the Town and Country Planning Appeal Board had been incorporated.

The variations aforementioned are as follows:

- (1) Re-route service lane in Commercial "C" zone. Area bounded by Burnett Street, Tancred Street, and West Street.
- (2) Extend Industrial "A" Zone and re-route service lane in block bounded by East Street, Moore Street, Cass Street, Mona Square, and Kermode Street.
- (3) Reduce width of service lane from 16 ft to 12 ft for a further distance of 16 ft along length of same block bounded by Baring Square, Cameron Street, Cass Street, and Havelock Street.
- (4) Extend Industrial "A" Zone over T.S. 917 to 919 inclusive, Walnut Avenue.

The Council has also resolved that the scheme shall come into operation on the 26th day of September 1960.

Copies of the scheme as approved have been deposited in the Council's office and in the Ashburton Public Library, these may be inspected, without fee, by any person who so requires at any time when these places are open to the public.
