All that area, being part of the Rangiriri Tribal District, bounded by a line commencing at the northern corner of Takauwhata Tribal Committee Area and proceeding generally, northerly, southerly, and westerly along the boundaries of the Rangiriri Tribal District hereinbefore described; thence northerly generally along the boundary of the Takauwhata Tribal Committee Area hereinbefore described to the point of commencement mencement.
