(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2. The boundaries of the Wairarapa Rabbit District, which was constituted by Order in Council on the 29th day of August 1945,\* are hereby altered and redefined and, as from the commencement of this order, the boundaries of the said district shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.

#### **SCHEDULE**

BOUNDARIES OF THE WAIRARAPA RABBIT DISTRICT

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ALL that area in the Wellington Land District comprising part of the Counties of Featherston, Masterton, and Wairarapa South and the Boroughs of Carterton, Featherston, Greytown, Martinborough, and Masterton, and bounded by a line commencing at a point on the shore of Palliser Bay in line with the northern boundary of Orongorongo A I, situated in Block IX, Pencarrow Survey District; thence north-easterly generally to and along that boundary, to and along the summit of the Rimutaka and Tararua Ranges to a point due west of the source of the Rumanhanga River; thence easterly generally along a right line to the source of that river and down the middle of that river to the Masterton-Castlepoint via Tinui road; thence easterly along that road to the south-western boundary of Section 514, Whareama District; thence south-easterly along that boundary and the western boundary of Section 604. Whareama District; thence south-westerly and south-easterly along the western and southern boundaries of the said Section 604 to the western boundary of Section 546, Whareama District; thence easterly generally along the western boundary of Section 546 afore-said, the northern boundary of the land shown on L.T. Plan B. 198, the northern boundary of the land shown on L.T. Plan B. 198, the northern boundary of the land shown on L.T. Plan B. 198, the northern boundary of Lot 5, D.P. 2303, and the northern boundary of the land shown on L.T. Plan B. 290, to the permanent Sate forest as described in Gazette, 1897, page 2188; thence north-easterly along the eastern boundaries of Sections 613 and 677, the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 10442, to the East Coast Road and the crossing of that road; thence northerly along the eastern side of that road to the southern boundary of Section 613, the southern boundaries of Sections 613 and 677, the eastern boundaries of Section 619, Pahaoa District, and the northern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 10442, to the East Coast Road and the crossing of that

thence south-westerly generally along the south-eastern boundary of Ngawakaakupe part 2D to the northernmost corner of Lot 5, D.P. 18208, along the north-western boundary of that lot, the south-eastern boundary of Lot 4, the north-western and south-western boundaries of Lot 3, the eastern boundaries of Lot 1, all as shown on D.P. 18208 aforesaid, to the southernmost corner of the last-mentioned lot; thence south-easterly generally along the northern boundaries of Lot 1. southernmost corner of the last-mentioned lot; thence south-easterly generally along the northern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 17182, part Lot 3, D.P. 1125, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Rere-whakaaitu River and down the middle of that river to the sea coast; thence south-westerly along the sea coast and northerly and westerly generally along the shore of Palliser Bay to a point in line with the northern boundary of Orongo-rongo A 1, being the point of commencement.

BOUNDARIES OF THE TOKIRIMA RABBIT DISTRICT

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All that area in the Taranaki and Wellington Land Districts, being portions of the Ohura Town District and Borough of Taumarunui, containing 202,191 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Ongarue River in line with the southern boundary of part Section 16, Block II, Rangi Survey District; thence southerly generally down the middle of that river and the Wanganui River to a point in line with the western boundary of Section 4, Block III, Hunua Survey District; thence southerly to and along that boundary to the generally north-easterly generally along that side of the said road to a point due north of the western end of the southern boundary of Section 2, Block III aforesaid; thence southerly along a right line to that boundary; thence south-easterly along a right line to the south-western boundary of Section 2, Block III aforesaid, and the south-western boundaries of Sections 5, 6, and 7. Block VIII, Hunua Survey District, to a point due north of the easternmost corner of Section 8, Block VIII aforesaid, thence southerly along a right line to and along that boundary of Section 2, Block III aforesaid, thence southerly along a right line to and along that boundary of Section 8, Block VIII aforesaid; thence southerly along a right line to and along that boundary of Section 8, Block VIII aforesaid; thence southern side of the Pokatea-Kokakonui road and the southern boundaries of Section 5, Block I, Kaitieke Survey District; thence south-western boundaries of Sections 2 and 4, Block VIII, Retaruke Survey District, aright line across Te Rata Road to and along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 7, and 1, Block I aforesaid, the northern and north-western boundaries of Sections 8, 2, and 4, Block VIII, Retaruke Survey District, a right line across Te Rata Road to and along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 9, 2, and 4, Block VII, Retaruke Survey District, a right line across Te Rata Road to and along the south-eas
