Amending a Proclamation Setting Apart Land as Permanent State Forest Land

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 24th day of February 1947 and published in *Gazette* on the 27th day of February 1947, at page 254, hereinafter referred to as the said Proclamation, an area of land in the Marlborough Land District, Marlborough County, containing 537 acres, more or less, being Section 58, Block I, Wakamarina Survey District, was set apart as permanent State forest land in terms of section 18 of the Forests Act 1921-22:

And whereas an error was made in the Schedule to the said Proclamation and it is desirable that this error be rectified:

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 21 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby amend the said Proclamation by omitting the said Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule hereto in lieu thereof, and I do hereby further declare that this Proclamation shall take effect as from the date on which the said Proclamation was intended to take effect.
