Whenuapai Aerodrome

THE Minister of Works, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1956, hereby gives notice that for the purpose of making the Whenuapai Aerodrome safe for aviation pur-poses he limits the erection, placing, or extension, without the consent of the Minister in Charge of Civil Aviation, of any building, pole, mast, or other structure of any kind or the growing of trees or shrubs of any kind on the land de-scribed in the First Schedule hereto to the respective levels defined in the Second Schedule hereto.

The sides of the said approach surface diverge on each side by 10 per cent of the distance out from the said base.

The two transitional surfaces lie one on each side of the said approach surface and rise outwards at a gradient of 1 in 7 as shown by serial contours on the said plan.

Ground contours are shown by the short-dash lines and are at 5 ft vertical intervals.
