RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Footpaths Improvement Loan 1960 of £6,000

NOTICE is hereby given that at a meeting of the above Council held on the 21st day of November 1960 the following resolution was passed.

"Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 the Te Kuiti Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of six thousand pounds (£6,000) authorised to be raised by the Te Kuiti Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of constructing concrete footpaths in various streets within the borough, the said Te Kuiti Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of five-sixteenths of a penny ($\frac{5}{16d.}$) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the Borough of Te Kuiti; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
