BAY OF ISLANDS ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Reticulation Extension Loan (No. 15) 1960, £100,000

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and its amendments, and of all other powers it thereunto enabling, the Bay of Islands Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the repayment of the principal, interest, and other charges on the Board's Reticulation Extension Loan (No. 15) 1960 of £100,000 authorised to be raised by the Bay of Islands Electric Power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of supplying and distributing electrical energy for the benefit of the Bay of Islands Electric Power District, and for such purpose to do all or any of such matters and things which the Board is empowered to do by the Electric Power Boards Act 1925 and its amendments, and by all other powers and authorities it enabling, the Bay of Islands Electric Power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of four-tenths pence ($\frac{4}{10}$ ths d.) in the pound (£1) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Bay of Islands Electric Power District; such special rate to be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the said loan and be payable yearly on the 8th day of December in each and every year, being a period of 20 years, or until the loan is fully repaid."

KAIKOHE BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Water Supply Loan of £28,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Kaikohe Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of twenty-eight thousand pounds (£28,000) authorised to be raised by the Kaikohe Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for augmenting the water supply, erecting storage, installing meters, and making reticulation extensions, the said Kaikohe Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of one and one-quarter pence ($1\frac{1}{4}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Kaikohe Borough District; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable half-yearly on the 1st day of August and the 1st day of February in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
