NASH, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby grants to John Henry Crockford and Mary Elizabeth Crockford, both of Wainui Bay, Takaka, sheepfarmers (hereinafter referred to as the licensees), a licence, subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, to take and use from McShanes Creek (hereinafter referred to as the said stream), situated in Section 5, Block 3, Square 12, Totaranui Survey District, in the County of Takaka, for the purpose hereinafter set forth, a stream of water not exceeding 2 cubic feet per second at any one time. time.

CONDITIONS

IMPLIED CONDITIONS

1. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Water Power Regulations 1934 and the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated in and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

(a) Headworks consisting of a dam and intake with a water race and pipeline leading to the powerhouse hereinafter referred to, giving a static head of approxi-

mately 52 ft.

Elton wheel and powerhouse with all necessary equipment for generating electricity, situated in Section 5, Block 3, Square 12, Totaranui Survey

District.

(c) Tail race leading from the said powerhouse to Wainui Bay.

SYSTEM OF SUPPLY
