RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Howick Borough Council hereby resolves:

"That for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a sewerage loan of £42,000 authorised to be raised by the Howick Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of sewerage reticulation, the said Howick Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.695d. in the pound (£) upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the rate district comprising the whole of the Borough of Howick; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years, or until such loan is fully paid off."
