*Allocating Land Acquired for Railway Purposes in the  
Ashburton County to the Purposes of a Road*

COBHAM, Governor-General  
A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 226 of the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First and Second Schedules hereto shall, upon the publication hereof in the *Gazette*, become a road and that the said road shall be under the control of the Ashburton County Council and shall be maintained by the said Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

##### RAILWAY LAND ALLOCATED TO ROAD

ALL that piece of land situated in Block VII, Corwar Survey District, containing 1 rood 33 perches, more or less, being part Rural Section 27399, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title, Volume 125, folio 8, Canterbury Registration, also, all that piece of land situated in Block XII, Spaxton Survey District, containing 1 acre 3 roods, more or less, being part Rural Section 26776, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title, Volume 105, folio 213, Canterbury Registration.
