Rubber, specially suited for use with Royle’s reducing valves (Tariff notice 77 refers.)</p> <p>Tubing— Cycle valve (Tariff notice 19 refers.) Plastic, ribbed, less than 6 mm external diameter (Tariff notice 52 refers.)
