RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Otamatea County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £10,000 authorised to be raised by the Otamatea County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing or erecting housing for staff and purchasing land incidental thereto, the said Otamatea County Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal one pence (0·1d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the County of Otamatea; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

This resolution was passed at a meeting of the Otamatea County Council held on Wednesday, 15 February 1961.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Otamatea County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £30,000 authorised to be raised by the Otamatea County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of making advances to farmers in terms of the Rural Housing Act 1939, the said Otamatea County Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal two three pence (0·23d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the County of Otamatea; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 35 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
