## HUTT VALLEY ELECTRIC POWER AND GAS BOARD

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Hutt Valley Electric Power and Gas Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £265,000 authorised to be raised by the Hutt Valley Electric Power and Gas Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing at the Board's depot adequate stores, garage, workshops, loading gantries, and works incidental thereto, the said Hutt Valley Electric Power and Gas Board hereby makes a special rate of four twenty-fifths of a penny in the pound ( $\frac{4}{25}$ d.) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Hutt Valley Electric Power District, comprising the Boroughs of Eastbourne, Petone, Upper Hutt, and Tawa, the City of Lower Hutt, part of the City of Wellington, part of the Hutt County, and part of Makara County; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
