

*Licensing the Ohiwa Harbour Board to Use and Occupy a Part of the Foreshore and Bed of the Sea at Kutarere, Bay of Plenty, as a Site for a Wharf*

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, the Minister of Marine hereby licenses and permits the Ohiwa Harbour Board (hereinafter called "the licensee", which term shall include its successors or assigns unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and bed of the sea at Kutarere, Bay of Plenty, as shown on plan marked M.D. 5007 and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, for the purpose of maintaining a wharf thereon as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

1. This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1960, and the provisions of those regulations shall, as far as applicable, apply hereto.

2. The annual sum payable by the licensee shall be one shilling (1s.), payable on demand.

3. The term of this licence shall be 14 years from the 21st day of January 1961.

4. The master of every vessel discharging ballast at the said wharf shall have all such ballast taken away and deposited above high-water mark, or at such place as may be approved by the Minister or by any person appointed by the Minister for that purpose.

*Licensing the Otago Harbour Board to Use and Occupy a Part of the Foreshore and Bed of the Sea at Taiaoroa Head as a Site for a Slipway*
