A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the portion of public reserve described in the first Schedule hereto is hereby taken for a public school and also hereby declare that an easement is hereby taken over the portion of public reserve described in the Second Schedule hereto, vesting in Her Majesty the Queen full and free right, liberty, licence, and authority in perpetuity to erect and maintain a storage tank on and to lay, construct, place, reconstruct, cleanse, repair, maintain, and inspect pipes along, under, or over the portion of public reserve described in the Second Schedule hereto and to store water in the said storage tank and convey water through the said pipes; and I also declare that the aforesaid easement shall be appurtenant to the land described in the First Schedule hereto; and I further declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 15th day of May 1961.
