TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1953

PUBLIC NOTIFICATION OF WAITEMATA COUNTY DISTRICT SCHEME

PUBLIC notice is hereby given that, pursuant to a resolution of the Waitemata County Council made on the 25th day of May 1961, section 1 of a district scheme has been recommended for approval under the Town and Country Planning Act 1953.

Section 1 of the scheme relates to the whole of the County area and in particular the following matters:

- The zoning or definition of areas to be used exclusively or principally for urban or rural purposes;
- The main communication routes;
- The provision and preservation of certain amenities, including the regulation and control of outdoor advertising;
- The control of subdivision, including restraint upon unnecessary encroachment of urban development upon land of high actual or potential value for the production of food;
- Land subdivision standards in relation to any permitted use;
- Minimum site areas and dimensions in relation to uses of land and buildings.

The scheme has been deposited in the county office in accordance with section 22 (1) of the Act and is there, open for inspection, without fee to all persons interested therein at any time when the county office is open to the public.

Objections to section 1 of the scheme shall be in writing in the form E prescribed in the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning Regulations 1960, and shall be lodged at the office of the Council at any time not later than 4.30 p.m. on 8 September 1961.
