(ii) Every public authority otherwise than as trustee or agent: (iii) Every Maori authority

(iii) Every Maon authority.
4. Land tax shall be due and payable in one sum on the 7th day of October 1961.
5. Income tax to which this order applies shall be due and payable in one sum on the 7th day of February 1962.
6. Land tax and income tax to which this order applies shall be payable at any office of the Taxes Division, Inland Revenue Department, or at any money-order post office.
