MOUNT ALBERT BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, the Mount Albert Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of £37,000 known as the Gladstone Road Overbridge Loan 1961 of £37,000 for the purpose of providing an overbridge across the railway line at Gladstone Road, Mount Albert, and meeting the costs of land purchases, provision of access to railway, and privately owned properties, claims for injurious affection, relocation of services, earthworks and road works in connection therewith, the Mount Albert Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal nought two six (.026d.) of a penny in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Mount Albert; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 30 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
