A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the additional land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken for a public school; and that for the purpose of providing access to the said public school an easement is hereby taken over the land described in the Second Schedule hereto, vesting in Her Majesty the Queen full and free liberty, right, licence, and authority in perpetuity to construct and use a right of way, with the right for Her Majesty's servants, agents, and workmen from time to time and at all times hereafter to go, pass, and repass, with or without horses or other animals, motor, or other vehicles, machinery, and implements, over the said land, and to maintain, repair, and keep open the said right of way, and that such right of way shall be appurtenant to the land described in the First Schedule hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 14th day of August 1961.
