### PATANGATA COUNTY COUNCIL

#### SPECIAL ORDER

#### Rural Housing Loan

THAT, whereas the Patangata County Council desires to raise a loan, pursuant to the provisions of the Rural Housing Act 1939, as amended and the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, from the State Advances Corporation of New Zealand for the purpose of advancing money to farmers within the county for the purpose of erecting dwellings; and whereas the Local Authorities Loans Board, at a meeting held on 16 May 1961, sanctioned the borrowing by Council of the sum of £25,000 (twenty-five thousand pounds) for the above-mentioned purposes, such loan to be known as Rural Housing Loan 1961.

A poll of ratepayers will be taken if 5 per cent of the ratepayers of the County of Patangata so demand by writing under their hands delivered or sent by post to the County Clerk before the date fixed for the confirmation of the resolution hereinbefore mentioned.
