Bylaw Regulating Traffic on State Highways and Fishing from Bridges on State Highways

PURSUANT to the National Roads Act 1953 and the Transport Act 1949 and all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling it in that behalf, the National Roads Board hereby makes the following bylaw.

BYLAW

B Y L A W 1. This bylaw may be cited as National Roads Board Bylaw 1961, No. 1. 2. This bylaw shall come into force on the day of its publication in the *Gazette*. 3. The National Roads Board may from time to time by resolution declare any portion of any State highway to be a one-way road, restrict all traffic on such portion to that pro-ceeding along such portion in one direction, and direct that signs shall be erected accordingly. 4. Where in terms of clause 3 of this bylaw in respect of any portion of any State highway all traffic has been restricted to that proceeding along such portion in one direction, no person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle or animal on such portion in a direction contrary to the terms of such restriction.

restriction. 5. The National Roads Board may from time to time by

5. The National Roads Board may from time to time by resolution prohibit all persons from fishing from any bridge or any part thereof on any State highway and direct that signs shall be erected accordingly. 6. Where in terms of clause 5 of this bylaw all persons have been prohibited from fishing from any bridge or any part thereof on any State highway, no person shall fish contrary to the terms of such prohibition. 7. Every person who commits an offence against this bylaw is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds (£20).
