Price Order No. 1861 (Amendment No. 3 of Price Order No. 1848) (Meat Retail)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following amending price order.

1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 1861 and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 1848* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. This order shall come into force on the 6th day of November 1961.

3. The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule thereto, and substituting the following Schedule.

"THIRD SCHEDULE

MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF MEAT TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES
