PURSUANT to section 186 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 and section 125 of the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby authorises the Mount Wellington Borough Council to permit the laying off of the proposed portion of a street described in the Schedule hereto at a width for part of its length of less than 66 ft, but not less than 40 ft, subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, and 30 of a subdivision of the land shown edged green on the plan marked M.O.W. 3936 referred to in the Schedule hereto within a distance of 15 ft from the side line of the said street.
