RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

THAT pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Alexandra Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £3,000 authorised to be raised by the Alexandra Borough Council for the purpose of purchasing a dwelling for use by a staff member, the said Alexandra Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of three-sixteenths of a penny (3/16d.) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Alexandra; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and payable yearly on the 1st day of July in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
