PURSUANT to the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Tokoroa Rural Fire District Order 1948, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tokoroa Rural Fire District Order 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. The principal order may hereafter be cited as the Tokoroa Rural Fire District Order 1948.

3. The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the First and Second Schedules and substituting the First and Second Schedules set out in the Schedule to this order.

SCHEDULE

NEW SCHEDULES TO PRINCIPAL ORDER

"FIRST SCHEDULE

"South Auckland Land District - Rotorua Conservancy

"ALL that area in Matamata, Rotorua, Otorohanga, and Taupo Counties, containing approximately 297,000 acres, situated in Patetere North, Patetere South, Wharepapa, Horohoro West, Horohoro, Ngautuku, Ranginui, Whakamaru, Te-Ati-a-muri, Ngongotaha, Marotiri, Tuhingamata West, Tuhingamata East, and Tatua Survey Districts, and bounded generally as follows: Commencing at the easternmost corner of part of the Kokako Block, Block XVI, Patetere North Survey District; thence by a right line to the north-eastern corner of Section 45, Selwyn Settlement, by Te Ranga No. 3 Block to the Korakonui Stream; thence by a right line to a point on the Mokaihaha Stream opposite the north-eastern corner of Te Whetu No. 3B 2 Block; thence by the Mokaihaha Stream and Patetere South No. 2 Block to the south-eastern corner of Te Whetu No. 3B 4 Block; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section 1, Block II, Horohoro West Survey District, by Patetere South No. 3B Block to its south-eastern corner; thence by a right line to the junction of the eastern boundary of Patetere South No. 2 Block with the northern side of the Pokaiwhenua Road; thence by the northern side of the aforesaid road to its junction with the Mamaku Road; thence by a right line to the north-eastern corner of Te Rimu Horohoro Block, and by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section 7, Block XIV, Horohoro Survey District; towards the south-east by the south-eastern side of the Rotorua-Atiamuri Main Highway to the bridge over the Taahunaatara Stream; towards the north-east by a right line between the last-mentioned point and the westernmost corner of Section 3, Block I, Ngongotaha Survey District, to a point 40 chains distant from the Rotorua-Atiamuri Main Highway; towards the south-east by lines 40 chains distant from and parallel to the aforesaid main highway and the Whangapoua Stream; towards the east by lines 40 chains distant from and parallel to the eastern boundary of Lot 3 on D.P. 16299; towards the north-east by a line 40 chains distant from and parallel to the right bank of the Waikato River to the Whirinaki Stream; towards the south-east by the Whirinaki Stream, the right bank of the Waikato River, by the crossing of that river, by Tauri No. 3A Block, and by Lot 2 on D.P. 16198 to its south-western corner; thence by a right line due west to the Waitoa-Taupo Main Highway, by the eastern side of that highway, by Sections 2 and 3, Block V, Tatua Survey District, and by Oruanui C, B, and A Blocks; towards the north-east by Oruanui A Block; towards the south-east by part of Oruanui No. 6 Block; towards the south-west generally by Whangamata 2E 1B and 2B 2B 1 Blocks; towards the south-east by a right line from the north-western corner of the last-mentioned block to the north-western corner of Tihoi 4C 1A Block; towards the west, south-west, and north-west by Tihoi No. 4B Block; again towards the west generally by Pouakani B 6B No. 8 Block to and across a road; towards the north-west by the north-western side of a road; towards the west by Pouakani B 6F No. 3E Block and the eastern boundary of that block produced to a point 40 chains distant from the western boundary of Tatua West Block; towards the north-west by right lines parallel to and 40 chains distant from Tatua West Block to Whakamaru Lake; towards the south generally by the southern shore of Whakamaru Lake to the Whakamaru Dam; towards the south-west by the south-western side of the Mangakino-Whakamaru road to the Mangakino Stream; towards the north-west by a right line to the south-western corner of the Mangakino Township subdivision; towards the north-east by the south-western boundary of the said township subdivision and the boundary produced to the Maraetai Lake; towards the west and south-west by the western and south-western shores of the Maraetai Lake to the Maraetai Dam; towards the east by a right line to the Waipapa-Mangakino road; towards the south and south-west generally by the last-mentioned road and the original Waipapa Access Road to the Waiteti Stream; thence by that stream to its junction with the Waipapa River, and thence by a right line to the south-western corner of Section 7, Block XII, Wharepapa Survey District; towards the north-west by the north-western side of the Arohana Road, by Sections 24 and 18, Block VIII, Wharepapa Survey District, and by a right line across the Arapuni Lake; towards the east by the eastern shore of Arapuni Lake to a point opposite the north-western corner of Subdivision 10, Waotu Farm Settlement; thence towards the north-west by a right line to the Common's Hill fire lookout tower situated in Block V, Patetere South Survey District; thence by a right line to the south-western corner of Matamuku 2A 2 Block and thence by the last-mentioned block; towards the west by Matamuku 2A 2 Block; towards the north by Matamuku part No. 3 Block to Stringer Road; towards the west by Stringer Road; towards the south-west generally by Matamuku part No. 3, and part No. 1A 2 Blocks, Waotu South C No. 10 Block, the western side of Waotu South Road, the Te Awamutu Road, and Waotu North part 2A 3 Block; towards the north-west by Waotu North 2B 2 Block; towards the north by the northern side of a road; towards the north-east by the north-eastern side of the Waotu-Lichfield Road, and by part of Waotu North C 4 Block; towards the north-west by Waotu North C 4 and 2r 3c Blocks; towards the north-east by Lot 8 on D.P. 24182 to the north-eastern corner of Waotu South C 6B Block; thence by a right line running north-east to the north-eastern corner of Lot 1 on D.P. 29981; thence in a northerly direction by the eastern side of Old Cambridge-Taupo Road to the southern corner of part Lot 2 on D.P. 21878; thence in a northerly direction by the eastern boundary of part Lot 2 aforesaid to the south-eastern boundary of Lot 1 on D.P. 51307; thence by the north-eastern boundary of Lot 1 aforesaid to its intersection with a road; thence by a right line in a north-easterly direction to Trig. O, Parapara, in Block X, Patetere North Survey District; thence south-easterly by a right line to Trig. 3, Opouaru, in Block XIV, Patetere North Survey District, and by that line produced to its junction with the Putaruru-Lichfield Back Road; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern side of that road to the corner of Lot 2 on D.P. 21573; thence in a south-easterly direction by the eastern boundary of Lot 2 on D.P. 21573 to and across a road; thence in an easterly direction generally by the northern boundaries of Lot 1 on D.P. 18663 and part Lot 2 on D.P. 19560 to the western boundary of Section 477 in the Town of Lichfield; thence southerly by the western boundary of Section 477 to its southernmost corner; thence easterly generally by the southern boundaries of Sections 477, 476, 475, and 474 in the Town of Lichfield to a road forming the eastern boundary of part of Lot 2 on D.P. 19560; thence southerly and easterly by that road to the easternmost corner of Section 129, Block XV, Patetere North Survey District; thence south-easterly by the north-eastern boundaries of Lot 3 on D.P. 18663 and Section 30, Block XV, Patetere North Survey District, to a point opposite the south-western corner of Lot 13 on D.P. 24825; thence by a right line in a south-easterly direction to the north-eastern corner of Lot 2 on D.P. 31566; thence southerly by the eastern boundary of Lot 2 on D.P. 31566 to the Tirau-Wairakei State Highway; thence across that highway by a right line to the northern boundary of part Lot 1 on D.P. 30130; thence in a north-westerly direction generally by the western boundaries of parts Lots 1 and 2 on D.P. 30130 and part Lot 1 on D.P. 34405 to a point opposite the north-eastern corner of part Lot 1 on D.P. 17083; thence by a right line to the north-eastern corner of part Lot 1 aforesaid; thence in a south-easterly direction along the north-eastern boundary of part Lot 1 on D.P. 29678 and the north-eastern boundary of part Lot 1 on D.P. 17083; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of part Lot 1 on D.P. 17083 to its southernmost corner; thence by a right line across the Paraoanui Road; thence north-westerly and south-westerly by the eastern and northern boundaries of Lot 1 on D.P. 34032; towards the north-east by Lots 2 and 3 on D.P. 23248; towards the north by Lot 3 aforesaid; towards the east by Section 43B, Selwyn Settlement, and the western boundary of the Pakuranga Block produced to the Old Cambridge-Taupo Road; towards the north-east by the north-eastern side of the last-mentioned road to the southernmost corner of Lot 21 on D.P. 23865; thence by Lot 21 aforesaid and by the Matarawa Stream; towards the north-west by the north-western side of Campbell Road; towards the south-west by the south-western side of the Waitoa-Taupo Main Highway; towards the north-west by the north-western side of Te Rere Road and by Lot 10 on D.P. 24825; towards the north-east by Lots 7 and 8 on D.P. 24825 and part of Kokako Block to a point 40 chains north of the Ngutuwhera Stream; towards the north by a right line due east to the south-eastern boundary of part of Kokako Block; and towards the north-west by the last-mentioned block. As shown on plan No. 37/20 deposited in the Head Office of the New Zealand Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red."
