71. Small-lots Scale

Paragraph 2: Omit this paragraph, and substitute the following:

2. Any consignment (except food products, clothing etc., for charitable purposes conveyed under the provisions of regulation 87, and used empty containers) not exceeding the quantity specified hereunder will be subject to an additional charge of 2s. 6d. if the freight is not prepaid—
- Goods not otherwise specified, not exceeding 5 cwt in weight.
 - Class G goods, not exceeding 10 cubic feet in measurement.
 - Timber, not exceeding 100 superficial feet in measurement.

88. Returned Empties

Omit this regulation.
