

- (a) By adding to the conditional uses relating to Commercial B zones the subclause "(f) any business which would not give rise to undue disturbance to the amenities of the neighbourhood generally", and by renumbering subclause "(f)" as "(g)";
- (b) By adding to the conditional uses relating to Industrial B zones the subclause "(h) any industry which would not give rise to undue disturbance to the amenities of the neighbourhood generally", and by renumbering subclause "(h)" as "(i)",

was approved by the Council by resolution passed at its meeting held on the 28th day of November 1961 after due notification of the proposal to change the scheme as above, and no objections or appeals had been received and no amendments had been required.

The Council has also resolved that the change in the scheme shall become operative on the 1st day of January 1962.
