Paekakariki Water Loan 1960, £30,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Hutt County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £30,000 authorised to be raised by the Hutt County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the construction of a $\frac{1}{4}$ -million-gallon reservoir and the extension and improvement of the water reticulation and house connections in Paekakariki, the said Hutt County Council hereby makes a special rate of 1.752 pence in the pound (1 and $\frac{752}{1000}$ ths pence in the £1) upon the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property in the Paekakariki Riding of the County of Hutt; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April and the 1st day of October in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 30 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
