*Boundaries of City of Nelson, County of Waimea, and Whangamoa Riding of County of Waimea Defined*

PURSUANT to section 26 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, the Secretary for Internal Affairs hereby defines, as set out in the Schedule hereeto, the boundaries of the City of Nelson, the County of Waimea, and the Whangamoa Riding of the County of Waimea, the previous boundaries having been altered by Order in Council made on the 13th day of April 1960 and published in *Gazette*, 21 April 1960, No. 26, page 521.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF CITY OF NELSON

ALL that area in the Nelson Land District bounded by a line commencing at a point on the western low-water mark at the Boulder Bank due west of the northernmost corner of Section 1132, City of Nelson, and proceeding due east along a right line to the northernmost corner of the said Section 1132; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section 1132 to its easternmost corner; thence south-easterly along a right line to the westernmost corner of Lot 3, D.P. 3202; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of the said Lot 3 and that boundary produced across No. 6 State Highway (Blenheim-Invercargill via Nelson and Greymouth) and again along the south-western boundary of the said Lot 3 to the north-western boundary of Section 60, Block IX, Wakapuaka Survey District; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundaries of the said Section 60 and Section 59, Block IX aforesaid, to the north-western corner of Section 58, Block IX aforesaid; thence generally southerly, easterly, and northerly along the western, southern, and eastern boundaries of the said Section 58 to the south-western corner of Section 59, Block IX aforesaid; thence easterly and northerly along the southern and eastern boundaries of the said Section 59 to the westernmost corner of Section 11, Block IX aforesaid; thence easterly and south-easterly along the southern and south-western boundaries of the said Section 11 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the left bank of the Maitai River; thence generally northerly, southerly, and westerly along the left bank of that river to a point in line with the western boundary of Section 11, Block IX aforesaid; thence southerly to and along that boundary to the northern boundary of Section 7, Block B, District of Wakatu; thence easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of the said Section 7 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the north-eastern corner of Section 8, Block B aforesaid, along the eastern boundaries of the said Section 8 and Sections 9 and 10, Block B aforesaid, to the easternmost corner of Section 11, Block B aforesaid; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of the said Section 11, that boundary produced to the easternmost corner of Section 19, Block B aforesaid, and the south-eastern boundaries of the said Section 19 and Sections 20 and 21, Block B aforesaid, to the northernmost corner of Section 1, District of Brook Street and Maitai; thence generally south-easterly and south-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section 1 and the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of Section 36, District of Brook Street and Maitai, to the north-eastern boundary of Section 35, District of Brook Street and Maitai, along the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of the said Section 35, the south-eastern boundary of Rural Section 1, District of Brook Street and Maitai, and the last-mentioned boundary produced through Sections 22 and 14, Square 18, to its intersection with the production of the south-western boundary of Section 3 of 8, District of Brook Street and Maitai; thence north-westerly to and along the south-western boundary of the said Section 3 of 8 to its westernmost point; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of the said Section 3 of 8, and Sections 10, 8, and 7, District of Brook Street and Maitai, to the south-western boundary of Section 29, Block D, District of Wakatu; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of the said Section 29 and Section 28, Block D aforesaid, and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the south-eastern corner of Section 21, Block D aforesaid, and along the south-western boundary of the said Section 21 to the south-eastern corner of part Section 6, District of Suburban South, as shown on D.P. 1637; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of the said part Section 6, that boundary produced across a public road and again along the south-eastern boundary of the said part Section 6 and the south-eastern boundary of part Section 7, District of Suburban South, as shown on D.P. 1637 to the easternmost corner of Lot 1, D.P. 210; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of the said Lot 1 to its northernmost corner; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundaries of the said Lot 1 and Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7, D.P. 210, to the westernmost corner of the said Lot 7; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of the said Lot 7 to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 2812; thence south-westerly to and along the north-western boundary of the said Lot 1 and the north-western boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 3300, to the eastern corner of Lot 5, D.P. 3300; thence north-westerly and south-westerly along the north-eastern and north-western boundaries of the said Lot 5 to its westernmost corner; thence north-westerly along a right line to the intersection of the north-eastern boundary of Lot 12, D.P. 4881, with the north-western boundary of Lot 4, D.P. 3300; thence generally south-westerly
