Declaring Lands in South Auckland, Wellington, Marlborough, and Otago Land Districts Vested in the South Auckland, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago Education Boards as Sites for Public Schools to be Vested in Her Majesty the Queen

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education Lands Act 1949, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the South Auckland Education Board, the land described in the Second Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Wellington Education Board, the land described in the Third Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Canterbury Education Board, and the land described in the Fourth Schedule hereto being an area vested in the Otago Education Board, as sites for public schools, shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof.

Declaring the Cairnhill and Earnsclough Rabbit Districts to be United to Form the Molyneux Rabbit District (Notice No. Ag. 7482)

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day of February 1962

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Rabbits Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares the Cairnhill Rabbit District and the Earnsclough Rabbit District, which were both constituted by Orders in Council on the 24th day of August 1949,* to be united and to form one district having the name of the Molyneux Rabbit District, the boundaries of which shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto, and further declares that the basis on which the Rabbit Board for the said district shall first levy its general rate shall be the acreage of the land occupied by the ratepayer.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF THE MOLYNEUX RABBIT DISTRICT

ALL that area in the Otago Land District, Counties of Vincent and Tuapeka, containing 93,000 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the westernmost corner of Run 500, Teviot Survey District, and proceeding generally north-westerly along the generally north-eastern boundary of Run 425c and the generally south-western boundaries of Runs 425b and 249A to the westernmost corner of Run 249A; thence generally north-easterly along the north-western boundary of that Run 249A and generally north-easterly, north-westerly, and again north-easterly along the north-western, south-western, and north-western boundaries of Run 249 to the westernmost corner of Section 4, Block XVI, Leaning Rock Survey District; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of that Section 4 and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the right (west) bank of the Clutha River; thence generally southerly along the right bank of that river to a point in line with the generally northern boundary of Run 500; thence generally westerly to and along the generally northern boundary of that run to the point of commencement.
