COBHAM, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the leasehold estate in the land described in the Schedule hereto, held from Her Majesty the Queen by Merivale Holdings Ltd. under and by virtue of Lease No. 23014, Auckland Land Registry, for a term commencing on the 1st day of September 1954 and terminating on the 30th day of April 1972, is hereby taken for a university; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 30th day of April 1962.

COBHAM, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the middle line of a road desired to be constructed over Blocks II, III, VI, VII, IX, and X, Hautapu Survey District, viz., a deviation of the Utiku-Mangaweka section of the Awanui-Bluff State Highway, shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall affect only the lands situated within the limits of the area bounded by broken red lines shown on the plan marked M.O.W. 4107 referred to in the Schedule hereto.

Wellington Land District
