ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of May 1962

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fire Services Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. On the 1st day of June 1962 the areas comprising the City of Palmerston North and the County of Kairanga and the Eastern Riding of the Oroua County are hereby constituted a united urban fire district by the name of the Palmerston North United Urban Fire District.

2. The number of members to be elected to represent the Councils of the City of Palmerston North and the Counties of Kairanga and Oroua on the Board of the District hereby constituted shall be three, who shall be elected in the following manner:

- Two members by resolution of the Palmerston North City Council.
- One member jointly by resolution of the Kairanga County Council and the Oroua County Council.
