S. 3313, and that last-named boundary produced to the middle of the Rotorua – Lake Tarawera Road; thence north-westerly along the middle of the said road to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Rotomahana Parekarangi 4A; thence along a right line between that last-mentioned point and the northernmost corner of part Rotomahana Parekarangi 6S 2B (State forest, *Gazette*, 1927, page 2897) to the intersection of the middle line of State Highway No. 5; thence northerly along the castern boundaries of Ngakuru and Mamaku Ridings as hereinbefore described of Ngakuru and Mamaku Ridings as hereinbefore described to and northerly generally along the generally eastern boundary of Rotorua Borough as described in *Gazette*, 1962, page 198, and north-easterly along the boundary of the Rotoiti Riding as hereinbefore described to the point of commencement.
