FIRST SCHEDULE

THE Wellington City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in Wellington City, by resolution declares that the provisions of section 128 of the Public Works Act 1928 shall not apply to the northern side of the portion of Drummond Street adjoining part Section 740, Town of Wellington, being all (or part) of the land in certificates of title, Volumes and folios Nos. 373/281; 373/280; 339/96 Ltd.; 339/104 Ltd.; and 329/277; Wellington Registry, as is more particularly shown on the plan annexed hereto.
