Change of City of Auckland District Scheme

PUBLIC notice is hereby given that, pursuant to a resolution of the Council made on the 2nd day of July 1962, the Council has recommended that the operative district scheme be changed in respect of the matters listed in the Schedule

The changes of the district scheme, as now recommended by the Council, have been deposited in the Town Hall (Town Planning Division), the Central Library, and each of the Branch Libraries, namely, Avondale, Epsom, Grafton, Grey Lynn, Parnell, Point Chevalier, Remuera, and Tamaki, and are there open for inspection by all persons interested therein, without fee, at any time when the above places are open to the public.

Objection to the proposed changes of the district scheme may be made by way of written notice in form E prescribed in the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning Regulations 1960 or to the like effect marked "objection to scheme change" and lodged at the office of the Council at any time not later than the 24th day of August 1962. An appropriate form for use by objectors is available from the town hall or from the libraries.

At a later date every objection will be open for public inspection. Any person who wishes to support or oppose any objection will then be entitled to be heard at the hearing of objections if he notifies the Council in writing within a period of which public notice will be given.
