A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart, subject to the drainage easement created in and by memorandum of transfer No. 583503 and to the building-line restriction contained in K. 57872, Auckland Land Registry, for transport purposes (vehicle testing station); and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 30th day of July 1962.
