WORKS RENEWAL LOAN 1962, SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Clutha County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £10,000 authorised to be raised by the Clutha County Council under the above-mentioned Act for repayment of portions maturing on 2 July 1962 and 30 March 1963, respectively, of Works Loan 1956, £45,000, and the Works Loan 1952, £15,000, the said Clutha County Council hereby makes a special rate of forty-eight thousandths of a penny in the pound (0.048d. in £) upon the rateable (unimproved) value of all rateable property of the whole of the County of Clutha; and that the special rate shall be a yearly recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
