*Wellington City Housing Loan 1962, £14,000*

THE following resolution was duly passed at a special meeting of the Wellington City Council held on Wednesday, 11 July 1962:

In pursuance and in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and its amendments, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of fourteen thousand pounds (£14,000) to be known as the Wellington City Housing Loan 1962 of £14,000 authorised to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of erecting flats for aged persons, the Wellington City Council hereby makes a special rate of four one-thousandths of a penny (0.004d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the City of Wellington; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each year during the currency of the said loan, being a period of thirty-five (35) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
