The New Zealand Law Society Rules Under the Law Practitioners Act 1955 (Amendment No. 1)

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Part VI of the Law Practitioners Act 1955, the Council of the New Zealand Law Society hereby makes the following rules:

1. The amount of the annual contributions to the Solicitors' Fidelity Guarantee Fund to be paid by solicitors to whom Part VI of the said Act applies shall, as from the 1st day of January 1963 and until a different amount shall be lawfully prescribed, be the sum of six pounds six shillings (£6 6s.).

2. This rule shall be in substitution for Rule 1 made by the Council on the 3rd day of December 1929 (*Gazette*, 12 December 1929, page 3248) which rule is hereby revoked.

3. These rules may be cited as the New Zealand Law Society Rules (Amendment No. 1).
