

2. The boundaries of the Awatere Rabbit District, which was constituted by Order in Council on the 29th day of April 1935*, are hereby altered and redefined and, as from the commencement of this order, the boundaries of the said district shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF THE AWATERE RABBIT DISTRICT

ALL that area of land in the Marlborough Land District, Marlborough, Awatere, and Kaikoura Counties, containing approximately 342,060 acres, bounded by a line commencing at Trig. Station Ref Wherside in Block VII, Wherside Survey District, and proceeding generally south-westerly, westerly, and again south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of Run 209, the south-eastern and southern boundaries of Run 121A, the south-eastern boundary of part Run 207, and the summit of the Inland Kaikoura Range to the point known as the Pinnacle, 54 chains north of Tapuenuku; thence along a right line bearing 240° true for a distance of approximately 215 chains to the summit of the said range; thence westerly and south-westerly along the summit of the said range to the south-western boundary of Section 1, Block IX, Tapuenuku Survey District; thence generally south-westerly and westerly along the south-eastern and southern boundaries of part Run 216 and the southern boundary of Run 219 to the westernmost corner of the said Run 219 in Block VI, Barefell Survey District; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of the said Run 219 to a point in line with the south-western boundary of the Muller freehold in Block I, Tone Survey District; thence north-westerly and north-easterly to and along the south-western and north-western boundaries of the Muller freehold to the northern boundary of Section 4, Muller Run, Awatere Registration District, in Block III, Barefell Survey District; thence north-westerly along a right line to the south-western corner of part Section 13, Langridge Run, Awatere Registration District, in Block XXII, Molesworth Survey District; thence northerly along the western boundary of the said part Section 13 and northerly and westerly along the western and southern boundaries of Run 218 to the western boundary of the said run, on the watershed between the Acheron and Awatere Rivers at a point approximately 72 chains south of Trig. Station Murphy in Block XXI, Molesworth Survey District; thence generally south-westerly, northerly, easterly, and southerly along the south-eastern, western, northern, and eastern boundaries of Run 220 to the north-western boundary of part Run 116 in Block I, Upcot Survey District; thence generally north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of the said part Run 116, Run 215 and Run 206, to Trig. Station Pudding Hill in Block XI, Spray Survey District; thence generally easterly along the watershed between the Awatere and Waihopai Rivers to the Avon Saddle at the southern corner of Section 163, Redwood Run, Waihopai Registration District, in Block VIII, Spray Survey District; thence northerly along the western boundary of the said Section 163 to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Section 135 of the said run; thence north-westerly to and along the said boundary and easterly along the northern boundary of the said Section 135 to the north-eastern corner of the said section; thence south-easterly along a right line to the north-western boundary of Section 161 of the aforesaid Redwood Run; thence generally north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of Sections 161 and 160 of the said Redwood Run, and Sections 156 and part 155, Waihopai Registration District, to the western boundary of Lot 13B, D.P. 664; thence southerly, easterly, and northerly along the western, southern, and eastern boundaries of the said Lot 13B to the boundary between part Run 109 and Run 109A in Block X, Hodder Survey District; thence easterly along that boundary to the watershed between the Awatere and Wairau Rivers in Block XI, Hodder Survey District; thence generally north-easterly and easterly along the said watershed to the south-eastern corner of Run 110 in Block VIII, Hodder Survey District; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of the said run and the right bank of the Omaka River to its intersection with a stream forming the southern boundary of Section 1, Castle Hill Run, Omaka Registration District, in Block XX, Avon Survey District; thence easterly and north-easterly along that stream and the southern and south-eastern boundaries of the said Section 1 to the Pig Gully Stream; thence generally easterly along the said Pig Gully Stream and the northern boundary of Section 1, Block XX, Taylor Pass Survey District, to the Blairich River, and along the right bank of that river to its intersection with the left bank of the Awatere River; thence generally south-westerly along the left bank of the said Awatere River to a point due west of the north-western corner of Section 5, Block XVI, Hodder Survey District; thence due east to that point; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section 5 and its production across the Awatere Valley Road to the northern corner of Section 6, Block XVI, aforesaid; thence south-easterly, southerly, and south-westerly along the north-eastern, eastern and south-eastern boundaries of the said Section 6, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the left bank of the Jordan River; thence generally south-easterly along the Jordan River and the north-eastern boundaries of Run 209, through Trig. Stations H and Mt. Malvern to Trig. Station Ref Wherside, the point of commencement.

PURSUANT to the Rabbits Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Marlborough Coast Rabbit District Order 1962.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The boundaries of the Marlborough Coast Rabbit District, which was constituted by Order in Council on the 21st day of December 1925,* are hereby altered and redefined and, as from the commencement of this order, the boundaries of the said district shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF THE MARLBOROUGH COAST RABBIT DISTRICT

ALL that area of land in the Marlborough Land District, Awatere and Kaikoura Counties, containing approximately 57,580 acres, bounded by a line commencing at the middle of the mouth of the Clarence River in Block XI, Puihi Puihi Survey District, and proceeding generally north-westerly, northerly, and north-easterly along the middle line of the said river to its intersection with the production of the middle line of Boundary Stream in Block XVIII, Wherside Survey District; thence along a bearing of 023° true for a distance of 100 chains and along a bearing of approximately 041° true for a distance of approximately 116 chains to peg LXIII, D.P. 705, on the boundary between D.P. 705 and Lot 2, D.P. 1340; thence northerly along the said boundary to the south-western corner of Lot 1, D.P. 1340; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the said Lot 1 to the watershed between Boundary Stream and the Kekerengu River; thence northerly along that watershed to Trig. Station Ragged Robin in Block VIII, Wherside Survey District; thence generally north-westerly along the south-western boundary of Section 5, Block VIII, aforesaid, to the boundary angle bearing approximately 137° true, distant approximately 105 chains from Trig. Station WH Wherside; thence north-westerly along a right line to the said Trig. WH; thence north-easterly along a line bearing approximately 072° true for a distance of 206 chains to the boundary of Section 4, Block IX, Wherside Survey District; thence easterly, southerly, and easterly along the southern, western, and southern boundaries of the said Section 4 to the south-eastern corner of the said section; thence generally northerly along the eastern boundaries of the said Section 4 and Sections 4 and 14, Block IV, Wherside Survey District, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the right bank of the Waima River; thence due north to the left bank of the said river; thence easterly along the said left bank to its intersection with the right bank of the Dunsandel Stream in Block XIX, Blue Mountain Survey District; thence north-westerly along the right bank of the said stream to a point in line with the north-western boundary of part Section 1, Block X, Cape Campbell Survey District; thence north-easterly to and along the said north-western boundary to Trig. Station Housetop; thence easterly and south-easterly along the northern and north-eastern boundaries of part Section 1, aforesaid, to the southernmost corner of part Section 2, Block X, aforesaid; thence easterly along a right line between the said southern corner of part Section 2 and Trig. Station Single Hill to its intersection with the western boundary of part Section 1, Block XI, Cape Campbell Survey District; thence southerly along the said western boundary and its production across a public road; thence easterly along the southern side of the said road to the sea coast; thence generally south-westerly along the sea coast to the point of commencement.
