A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the 1st day of December 1961 and published in the Gazette of the same year at page 1859, allocating land taken for railway purposes at Manurewa to the purposes of a street, and hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto shall, upon the publication hereof in the Gazette become a street and that the said street shall be under the control of the Manurewa Borough Council and shall be maintained by the said Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.
