ORDER

1. That on and from the 1st day of April 1963 the area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby excluded from the County of Taupo and included in the County of Hawke's Bay. 2. That the alteration of the boundaries of the said counties hereinbefore made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Counties Act 1956.
