Revoking in Part a Proclamation Taking Land Near Kioreroa

BERNARD FERGUSSON, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the 11th day of December 1958 and published in *Gazette*, No. 77, of that year, at page 1848, taking land at Kioreroa for railway purposes in so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto.
