## ORDER

1. That on and from the 1st day of April 1963 the area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby excluded from the County of Masterton and included in the Borough of Masterton.

2. That the alteration of the boundaries of the said county and the said borough herein before made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Municipal Corporations Act 1954.
