AUCKLAND ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

General Extension and Improvement Loan 1962 (No. 2) of £700,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Auckland Electric Power Board Act 1921-22, the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, the Auckland Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

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"That, for the purpose of providing the principal interest, and other charges on a loan of £700,000, known as the General Extension and Improvement Loan 1962 (No. 2) of £700,000, for the purpose of further reticulation of the Board's area and extending, strengthening, and reorganising the supply within that area, the Auckland Electric Power Board do hereby make and levy a special rate of one-seventeenth ($\frac{1}{17}$) of a penny in the pound (£) on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Auckland Electric Power District, comprising the City of Auckland together with the boroughs of Ellerslie, Howick, Manurewa, Mt. Albert, Mt. Eden, Mt. Roskill, Mt. Wellington, Newmarket, Onehunga, One Tree Hill, Otahuhu, Papakura, and Papatoetoe, the county of Manukau, and the road district of Waiheke; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 12 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
